AI for Impact

Individual or team app challenge, built around a social-impact problem.



TRACK 02

Young Entrepreneurship

Structured startup document plus a one-minute recorded pitch.



TRACK 03

Puzzle Master

Individual timed games in IQ, EQ, logic and reasoning.



TRACK 04

Content Creator

Individual or team one-minute video on the annual theme.

50,000 new Atal Tinkering Labs

The Union Budget 2025-26 announced new labs in government schools over five years to widen hands-on access to innovation.

Atal Tinkering Labs develop design thinking, computational thinking, prototyping and solution-building among school students.

The agenda includes ideation, design thinking, intellectual property, startup finance, entrepreneurship and prototype development.

Aligned with the Union Budget 2026-27 push for AVGC skills and a national creator-talent pipeline.

15,000 secondary schools

The Government announced AVGC Content Creator Labs for secondary schools, alongside 500 colleges, with an outlay of INR 250 crore.

Skills for the Orange Economy

The initiative expands access to animation, visual effects, gaming, comics, digital storytelling and content-production skills.

A single in-person flagship event. The top three entries in every competition and division from each state attend.

Travel and accommodation for the national finals are borne by schools or families

Winning is paired with mentorship and practical next-step support.

AI for Impact

Prizes up to INR 1 lakh, plus mentorship, deployment guidance and support to scale.

Young Entrepreneurship

Prizes up to INR 1 lakh, plus mentorship and venture-building support to scale.

Puzzle Master

Prizes up to INR 50,000 across the Classes 5–8 and Classes 9–12 divisions.

Content Creator

Prizes up to INR 1 lakh, plus mentorship and creator or brand support to scale.



Your school's role, start to finish

Five steps across the academic year.

01

Register the school

Sign up and appoint one official school coordinator as the point of contact.

02

Promote the programme

Share it with students and families, and identify participants across all four tracks.

03

Use the workshops

Optional preparation sessions build awareness and practical capability before entry.

04

Support the screening

Help students submit valid entries to the free online school round.

05

Back the progression

Support selected students through the state round and on to the national finals.

06

Collect the recognition

Receive media coverage and school award certificates for participating.

Recognition is not reserved for the winning school.
